



GREENHOUSE AND SUMMERHOUSE WOOD PRESERVATIVE

The cedar used in Alton's products has an inherent resistance to rot. If the cedar is not regularly re-treated the colour will fade to silvery-grey.

Alton currently uses an exclusive Golden Honey Wood Preservative on all greenhouses and summerhouses. The warm, natural colour looks superb in any garden setting and the additional wax content helps disperse rainwater. To maintain the original colour, additional cans of Golden Honey Wood Preservative can be purchased directly from Alton or via your local retailer.

The current Golden Honey treatment was introduced in 2006. Prior to this (between 2002 and 2005), the treatment used on all Alton products was "Premium Alton Beech" - a water-based treatment, containing wax to help disperse rainwater, whilst enriching and protecting the timber.

We are able to supply you with both Golden Honey & Premium Alton Beech wood preservatives. Please choose the appropriate version relating to when your greenhouse was delivered. If your Alton was delivered before 2002, then Golden Honey will be most suitable.

HOW MUCH IS REQUIRED?

Coverage depends on many different factors including moisture content and cleanliness of the timber, but a rough guide to help you (based upon 2 coats) is given below.

Greenhouses: All models up to 20' long 2.5 litres. Octagonal models 5 litres.

Summerhouses: Felt Roof Models 5 litres. Cedar Roof Models 5 to 7.5 litres.
